GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

This show is a regular member of the United States Equestrian Federation. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

ENTRIES: Entries close May 25 for week 1, June 1 for week 2. New entries (new or different horses) made after this date will incur a one time late fee of \$25.00. **Class entries made THE DAY OF THE CLASS will be charged a \$5/class post entry fee; regardless of the entry's status (e.g. "late" or received on time)** Every Entry Blank must have the signature of the owner/authorized agent, trainer & be accompanied by stall fees paid in full or an open check. It is the responsibility of the person making the entry to execute properly and complete all necessary information pertaining to each entry made in accordance with USEF rules. **NO NUMBERS WILL BE ISSUED WITHOUT AN OPEN CHECK.** CURRENT COGGINS MUST BE PRESENTED TO THE HORSE SHOW OFFICE. Show Management reserves the right to refuse any entry for any reason.

***Warning: Horses that compete in a class in which they are not properly entered will be charged a double entry fee.** Once a horse has competed in the first class of an "AA" rated hunter section, the division entry fee cannot be refunded.

***Attention foreign exhibitors:** All fees MUST be paid in "US Funds" with checks drawn on a U.S. Bank. This show DOES NOT accept credit/debit cards.

OFFICE FEE: All horses, showing or non-showing, will be charged a \$35 office fee in addition to their stall or day hauler fee.

STALLS: STALLS WILL NOT BE RESERVED WITHOUT PREPAYMENT IN FULL OR A SIGNED, OPEN CHECK SENT WITH AN ENTRY BLANK. Permanent 12 X 12 stalls of wood/steel construction, with doors, are available Monday afternoon, June 8. **Cost per stall is \$200.** Feed, Hay, and Bedding will be available on the show grounds. Bedding may be ordered in advance by contacting the stable manager at (901) 289-5701. Stalls will not be assigned until payment or an open, signed, check is received. Manure is to be disposed of in designated areas only. **NO MANURE IN TRASH CONTAINERS. No stall doors or panels may be removed.**

DAY HAULERS: A fee of \$20.00 will be charged for day haulers plus any other applicable fees.

NON-NEGOTIABLE CHECKS: Exhibitors who attempt to pay their fees with a non-negotiable check will be charged an extra \$50 and reported to the USEF. Unless payment is received in full within 30 days of the last day of each show, exhibitors may be eliminated from future competitions managed by Southbound Shows LLC and/or EquiShow Inc.

CREDENTIALS: ALL EXHIBITORS IN ANY PONY, JUNIOR HUNTER OR AMATEUR SECTION MUST PRESENT THEIR CREDENTIALS TO THE SHOW OFFICE BEFORE THEIR NUMBERS CAN BE RELEASED. Kindly send a photo copy of credentials with entry to facilitate processing. All horses or ponies without a valid measurement card will be measured at a designated time and place. Anyone not presenting valid membership credentials (USEF/USHJA) will be charged a non-member fee.

DRUGS and MEDICATIONS: Current USEF rules relating to drugs and medications will be enforced. Each horse entered must pay \$7 Drug/Medication Fee plus a \$8 USEF fee.

SCHOOLING: Hunter Rings will be open for schooling on the day prior to the show. Time permitting, rings will also be open before and after the show, each day, for hacking. Times to be posted or announced. **Jumping will be permitted only when medical personnel are on the grounds.**

DOGS: Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, as well as issuance of warning cards pursuant to rule GR 301.

CHANGES: Management reserves the right to change, cancel, or combine classes, alter courses and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries.

ATTIRE/HEADGEAR: All riders must be properly attired. Numbers must be worn and clearly visible. Protective head gear must be worn **BY ALL RIDERS AT ALL TIMES WHILE MOUNTED**, anywhere, anytime on the show grounds. Headgear for **all riders** must meet or exceed ASTM Standards; must carry the SEI tag; and be properly secured by a harness. (See GR318)

JUMPERS: All Horses showing in Jumper classes offering prize money must be recorded with USEF except where prohibited by law. Any change of horses name and/or ownership must be recorded with the Federation. **Ties in jumper classes will jump off for first place only. Ties for all other places will be determined by first round time.** Ties for Champion and Reserve will remain tied.

NOMINATING FEE: Horses competing in classes 1.25 Meter AND ABOVE must pay a nominating fee of \$175.

RINGS/FOOTING: Indoor ring is 150' X 270'. Covered Arena is 150' X 300'. Outdoor ring is 225' X 125'. Footing in both rings is sand/clay mix. Footing in outdoor ring is all-weather sand.

JUMP ORDER: A rotating jump order will be established for all classes over fences. Riders or Trainers with conflicts must see the paddock masters in both rings so that the necessary adjustments can be made. **Starters have the authority to scratch entries that make no attempt to be timely, without going through the Steward or Show Manager.**

COURSES: Courses will be posted a minimum of one hour prior to each class. In Hunter classes, fences will simulate fences found in the hunt field such as; brush, wall, in & out, oxer, post and rails, and gates. At management's discretion, a dotted line may be put into effect to restrict the size of the courtesy circle in hunter classes.

POLING: Manual poling and the use of Bamboo Offsets are prohibited at all times on the Show Grounds. In the event of a violation of this regulation, the involved horse, owner, rider, and trainer of record may be suspended from further competition at the show where the violation occurred.

RIBBONS/TROPHIES/CHAMPIONSHIPS: All hunter classes receive a trophy (or prize money) and eight ribbons unless otherwise noted. All jumper classes receive a trophy (or prize money) and six ribbons unless otherwise noted. Each hunter section will receive a champion & reserve award based on points. The only jumper sections to receive champion and reserve awards will be the Pony Jumper, Childrens/Adult Amateur and the Low/High Jr/AO Jumper sections.

PRIZES: Prize money is indicated for each class. Prize money won can be paid by check or deducted from each horses account. An IRS W-9 form must be completed in full before any prize money exceeding \$600 can be paid. Prize money will be withheld if Social Security number is not on file. Prize money will be payable to the owner unless written authorization is on file with the show secretary.

CAMPERS: There is a full campground available at the arena. Hookups cost \$200 per week.

OPERATION OF MOTORIZED VEHICLES: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will **not** be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described vehicles so long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

USEQUESTRIAN MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides provided the respective breed/discipline dues or breed/discipline category fee has been paid. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the requirements of this rule; 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot or academy classes 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions 8) Opportunity classes 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation; 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 9) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-recognized Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4

RESPONSIBILITY: Submission of entry to this show constitutes an agreement to the following: Exhibitor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Tunica Expo Center, Graceland Partnership d/b/a Germantown Partners, Southbound Shows LLC, EquiShow Inc., Carol Vos, The Delta Blues Horse Show and the Tunica High Rollers Horse Show officials harmless against any claims, demands, costs and expenses, including reasonable attorney fees for the defense thereof, arising from the conduct or management of Exhibitor's business or its use of the premises or from any breach on the part of the Exhibitor of any conditions of this Agreement, or contractors, agents, employees, guests or invitees in or about the premises. In case of any action or proceeding brought against the Tunica Expo Center, Germantown Partners and/or EquiShow Inc., The Delta Blues Horse Show and/or the Tunica High Rollers Horse Show management by reason of such claim Exhibitor, upon notice, covenants to defend such action or proceeding by council acceptable to owner. Exhibitor is responsible for his/her own property and the Tunica Expo Center, Mid-South Show Management, The Delta Blues Horse Show and The Tunica High Rollers Horse Show Management are not responsible for accidents, fire or theft.
